INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Congratulations to the purchase of this Max Music product. Please read this manual thoroughly prior to using the product in order to benefit fully from all features.

Read the manual prior to using the product. Follow the instructions in order not to invalidate the warranty. Take all precautions to avoid fire and/or electrical shock. Repairs must only be carried out by a qualified technician in order to avoid electrical shock. Keep the manual for future reference.

- Prior to using the product, please ask advice from a specialist. When the unit is switched on for the first time, some smell may occur. This is normal and will disappear after a while.
- The unit contains voltage carrying parts. Therefore do NOT open the housing.
- Do not place metal objects or pour liquids into the product. This may cause electrical shock and malfunction.
- Do not place the product near heat sources such as radiators, etc. Do not place the unit on a vibrating surface. Do not cover the ventilation holes.
- The product is not suitable for continuous use.
- Be careful with the mains lead and do not damage it. A faulty or damaged mains lead can cause electrical shock and malfunction.
- When unplugging the product from a mains outlet, always pull the plug, never the lead.
- Do not plug or unplug the unit with wet hands.
- If the plug and/or the mains lead are damaged, they need to be replaced by a qualified technician.
- If the product is damaged to such an extent that internal parts are visible, do NOT plug the unit into a mains outlet and DO NOT switch the product on. Contact your dealer. Do NOT connect the product to a rheostat or dimmer.
- To avoid fire and shock hazard, do not expose the product to rain and moisture.
- All repairs should be carried out by a qualified technician only.
- Connect the product to an earthed mains outlet (220-240Vac/50Hz) protected by a 10-16A fuse.
- During a thunderstorm or if the product will not be used for a longer period of time, unplug it from the mains. The rule is: Unplug it from the mains when not in use.
- If the product has not been used for a longer period of time, condensation may occur. Let the unit reach room temperature before you switch it on. Never use the product in humid rooms or outdoors.
- During operation, the housing may become hot.
- To prevent accidents in companies, you must follow the applicable guide lines and follow the instructions.
- Do not repeatedly switch the product on and off. This shortens the life time.
- Keep the unit out of the reach of children. Do not leave the unit unattended.
- Do not use cleaning sprays to clean switches. The residues of these sprays cause deposits of dust and grease. In case of malfunction, always seek advice from a specialist.
- Only operate the product with clean hands.
- Do not force the controls.
- If the product has fallen, always have it checked by a qualified technician before you switch the product on again.
- Do not use chemicals to clean the unit. They damage the varnish. Only clean the product with a dry cloth.
- Keep away from electronic equipment that may cause interference.
- Only use original spares for repairs, otherwise serious damage and/or dangerous radiation may occur.
- Switch the product off prior to unplugging it from the mains and/or other equipment. Unplug all leads and cables prior to moving the product.
- Make sure that the mains lead cannot be damaged when people walk on it. Check the mains lead before every use for damages and faults!
- The mains voltage is 220-240Vac/50Hz. Check if power outlet match. If you travel, make sure that the mains voltage of the country is suitable for this product.
- Keep the original packing material so that you can transport the product in safe conditions

UNPACKING INSTRUCTION

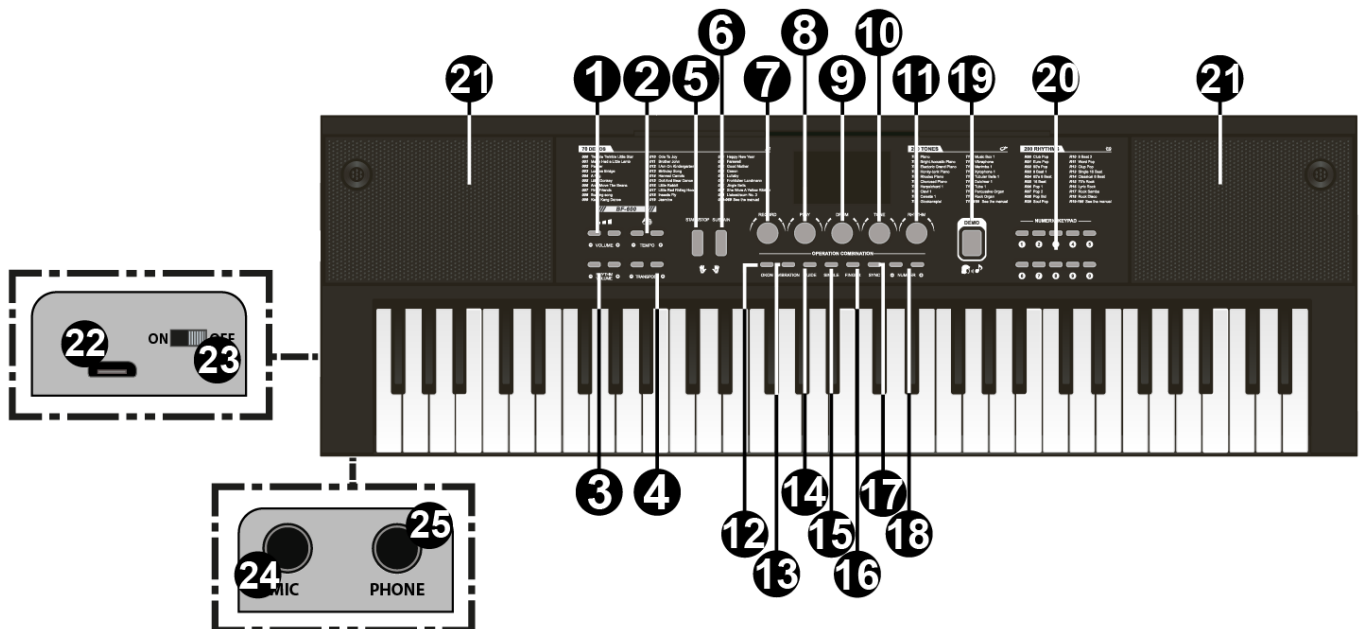
POWERSUPPLY

The label on the bottom of the product indicates to what type of power supply the product must be connected. Check that the mains voltage corresponds to this, all other voltages may cause irreparable damage. The product must also be directly connected to the mains, no dimmer or adjustable power supply.



Always connect the device to a protected circuit (circuit breaker or fuse). Make sure the device has an appropriate electrical ground to avoid the risk of electrocution or fire.

CONTROLS



- 1. MASTER VOLUME**
Press [Master Vol +] or [Master Vol -] to raise or lower the master volume.
- 2. TEMPO**
Press [Tempo +] or [Tempo -] to increase or decrease the rhythm speed.
- 3. RYTHME VOLUME**
Press [Rythme Vol +] or [Rythme Vol -] to raise or lower the accomp volume.
- 4. TRANPOSE**
Press [+] or [-] to accurately correct the pitch from “-6” to “+6”.
- 5. START/STOP**
Press to start or stop playing selected program.
- 6. SUSTAIN**
Press this button to extend the sound of the key.
- 7. RECORD**
Press Rec Button and you can record the music you play. It can record 85 notes, if the song is more than 85 notes; it will automatically record the first 85 notes.
- 8. PLAY**
Press to playback recorded notes or rhythms.
- 9. KEYBOARD DRUMS**
Please refer to the appendix 5 for the list of keyboard drums/animal sounds. There are total 61 voices for percussions and animals sounds with 61 different keys. Press the button “Drum” again to exit this function.
- 10. TONE**
The factory setting tone is piano, There’re totally 200 tones, please refer to the appendix 2 for all details

Press "tone" button, and enter into the digital buttons area to choose the tone you need. Tone starts from "00" to "199" and if the input is out of this range, it will be ineffective.

11. Rhythm

There're totally 200 rhythms, please refer to the appendix 3 for all details. Press "start/stop" button to start the rhythm you need. Rhythm starts from "00" to "199" and if the input is out of this range, it will be ineffective.

12. Okon (one key for one note)

Press this button and choose the Demo number with the digital buttons, it will start to play background music from the demos, and you can play any black or white keys which will be automatically correct as the demos.

13. VIBRATION

Press this button to have the vibrating sound.

14. Guide

Press "Guide" to enter this mode and choose the Demo number with the digital buttons, it will start to play background music from the demo. User can play the song with the memory to follow the background music. If you want to stop, then press "Start/Stop" button. In this step, you can adjust the tempo according to your own speed that you like.

15. SINGLE FINGER CHORD (Please refer to the appendix 4 for fingering)

Press "RHYTHM" and choose any rhythm, then press "Single" to enter this mode.

Next, play one of any 20 keys on the most left hand side to start the chord. Press "SINGLE" again to exit this function.

16. FINGERED CHORD (Please refer to the appendix 4 for fingering)

Press "RHYTHM" and choose any rhythm, then press "Finger" to enter this mode.

Next, play one of any 20 keys on the most left hand side to start the chord. Press "Finger" again to exit this function.

17. SYNC

Under this mode, the rhythm and chord will synchronize with the tone. Press this button and the LED display will show "SY" on the screen. Choose the "Rhythm and Tone NO". and choose Single Finger Chord or Fingered Chords, Then the left hand could play the chords and the right hand play the tones at the same time.

18. NUMBER - / +

Select the number in your screen with one up or one down.

19. DEMO

Totally 70 Demos, please see appendix 1 for full details.

Press DEMO, it will play songs in continuous playback mode and starts from song NO. "00" to "69" or pressing the button "+" "-" to choose the right numbers of the songs you need. If you want to stop, press the button "DEMO" Again, Or just press the start/stop button.

20. DIGITAL BUTTONS

Press the number you need to choose the TONE, RHYTHM or DEMO numbers. Or Press "+" button or "-" button for more than 2 seconds to increase or reduce the numbers showed in the Display. When you input the numbers to choose the TONE, RHYTHM or DEMO, please press the numbers within the Limit, Otherwise the input is ineffective. For Example, the limit of DEMO is only 69, input of 71 will be ineffective. For example, the limit of demo is only 69, input of 71 will be ineffective.

21. SPEAKERS

Loudspeakers to reproduce the sound of the music played. sound level is determined on the basis of the volume setting.

CONNECTIONS

22. DC INPUT

Socket for plugging in the supplied micro USB power cable.

23. POWER ON/OFF

Switch to turn the keyboard on or off.

24. MICROPHONE INPUT

Connect a microphone to the MIC port to sing while playing the keyboard.

25. HEADPHONES/OUTPUT

When connecting headphones to the PHONES/OUTPUT port, the loudspeaker will be disabled automatically. You can perform without disturbing others and other disturbing you.
